#### A. **SSF for Bags and Baskets Making in Labo, Camarines Norte**

*SSF for bags and Baskets provide machineries, tools and equipment to improve productivity, product quality and marketability of the bags & baskets in the province. The SSF will be used by the target MSME beneficiaries in upgrading their production methods.*
