

The Professional Regulation Commission (PRC) reported that 6,835 out of 18,436 examinees (37.07%) passed the exams, with **CNSC** achieving an institutional passing rate of 50.63%.





Number of Adopters Engaged in Profitable Enterprise






Percentage of Beneficiaries who rate the Training Course as Satisfactory or Higher in Terms of Relevance
