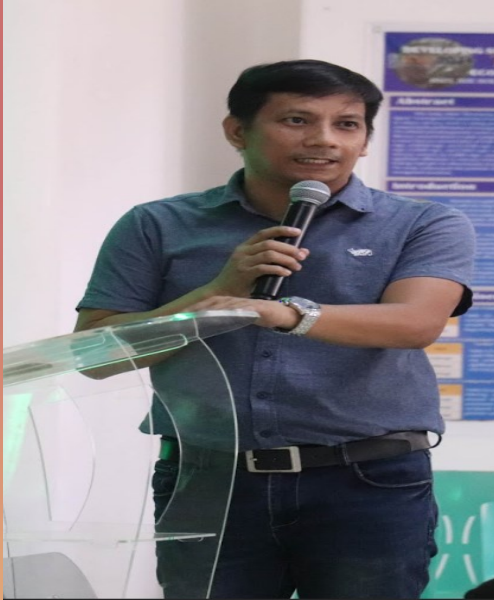

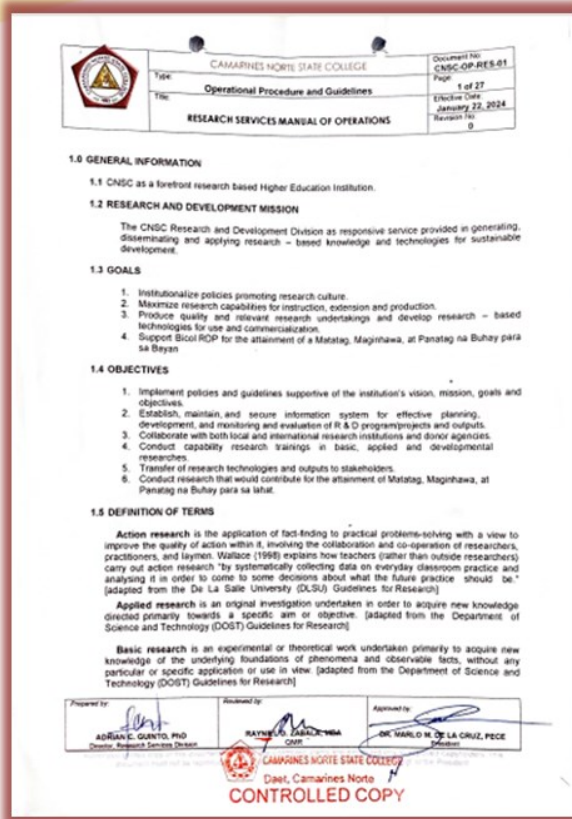
Research Agenda

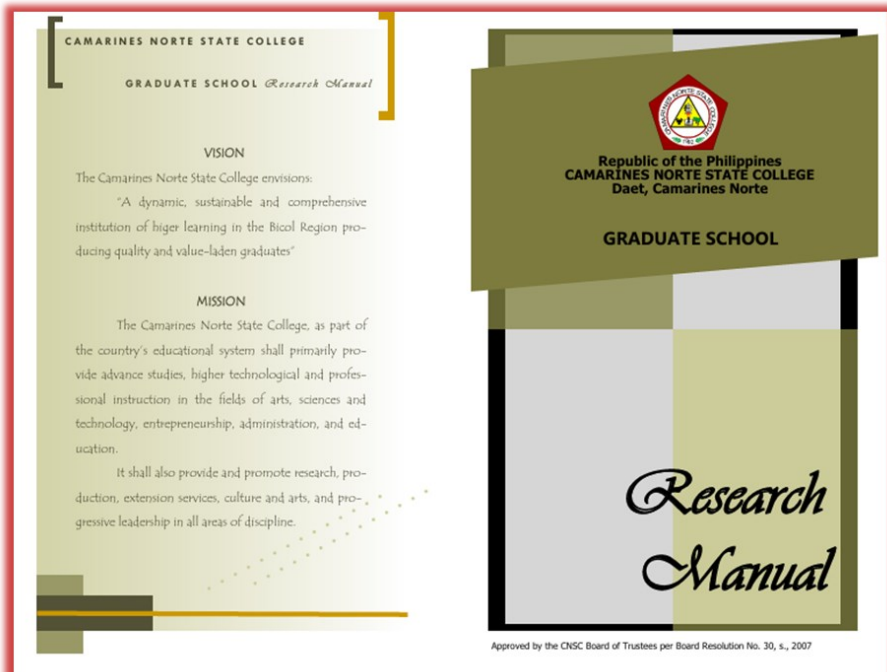
Research Manual

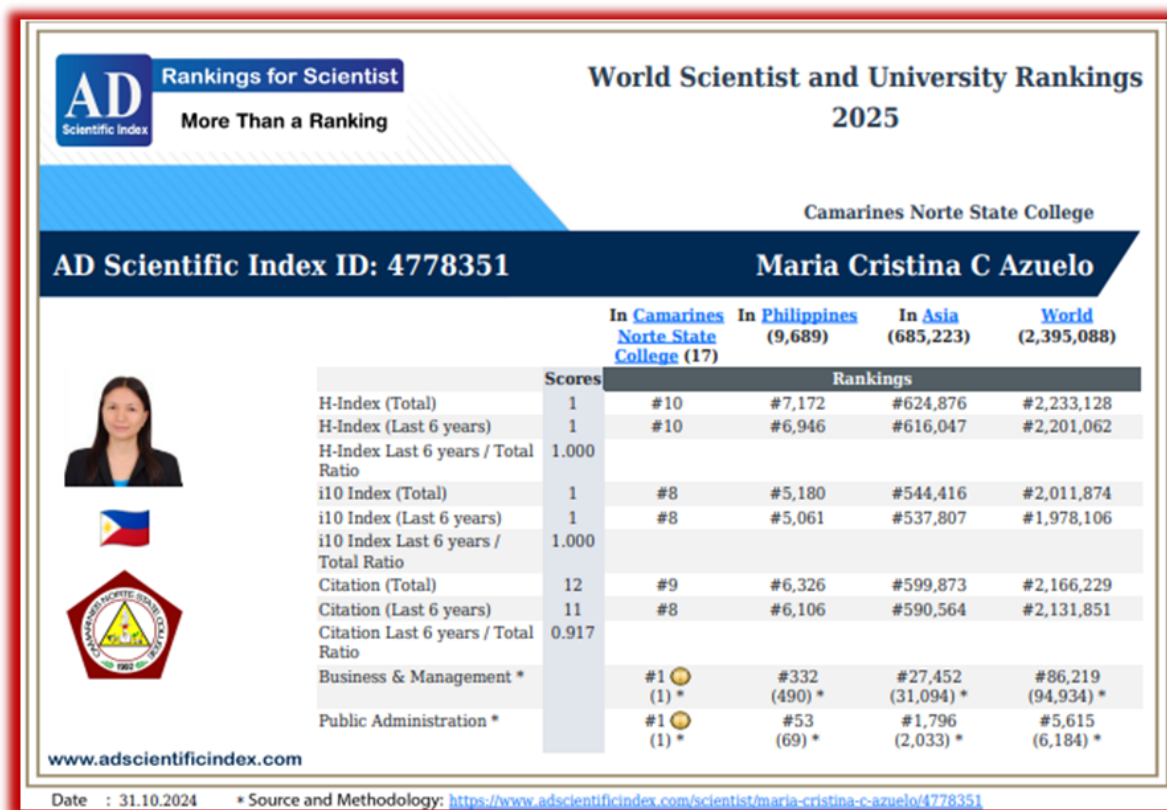

- Co-authored with GG Sanglay, published in the *International Journal of Research and Scientific Innovation*, this research assesses the effectiveness of livelihood programs aimed at alleviating poverty; **Mt. Guinatungan, Camarines Norte, Philippines: Unknown Haven of Rafflesia manillana Teschem. NAVAL is a distinguished associate professor and author in the field of business administration, currently serving as the Program Chairperson for the Doctor of Business Administration at Camarines Norte State College and the Extension Services Unit Director. With a Doctorate in Business Administration from Ateneo De Naga University (2016) and a Master in Management specializing in Human Resource Management (2007), she brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise to her role. Dr. Naval's academic journey began with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration majoring in Marketing from Rizal Technological University (1999) and continued with foundational education at The Sisters of Mary School and Dela Paz Elementary School. A dedicated educator, she has held various leadership positions, including Program Chairperson for the BSBA


major in Marketing Management from 2016 to 2019. As an Associate Professor II, Dr. Naval is committed to fostering a learning environment that empowers students to excel in business. In addition to her teaching and administrative roles, Dr. Naval is a published author, with notable works including "Strategic Marketing Management: Simplified Moves for Rookies" (2021) and the "Business Plan Guidebook" (2017). In addition to his research, Dr. Abad has contributed to the educational needs of indigenous communities through his project "Literacy Intervention for the Tribe (Project LIFT)" (2022). He holds a Doctor of Education with a major in Educational Leadership and Management from Bicol University and a Master's degree in Educational Leadership and Management from Mabini Colleges. Recognized for his research excellence, he became a member of the National Research Council of the Philippines and was awarded Best Research Presenter at the World International Research Conference in Thailand (2019) and Best Paper at the Central Luzon State University International Gender Responsive Research Forum.
